**By Credit Card...** Pay your tax bill over the internet 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

A private company charges a fee for this service equal to 2.39% of the payment, \$1.50 for e-check and \$3.95 for debt cards. To pay visit: [www.co.green.wi.gov](http://www.co.green.wi.gov) using the quick link "Pay Taxes Online".

**By Escrow Check...**

Any arrangements with an escrow agent are between you and that agent. If you are paying with an escrow check, please make sure your check is endorsed before it is given to the County. Checks made payable jointly or singly to the County cannot be deposited in your personal bank account and will not be endorsed back to the taxpayer. Escrow checks must be applied to the entire outstanding tax bill. If an escrow check is more than the actual amount due, you will be issued a refund check made to the owner of record right away. Ten days if it is a personal check.

**By drop box...** After hours drop box is located on the east door of the courthouse.

**When do I owe my taxes?**

At least the first installment must be paid by January 31, 2019. The first installment includes one-half of your property taxes and 100% of any special charges. The second installment is due by July 31<sup>st</sup> of each year to Green County Treasurer.

**Am I eligible for the Lottery Credit?**

You are if the property is your primary residence and if you or a previous owner lived in the home on January 1, 2018.

If the lottery credit is not on your tax bill, you may obtain the "Lottery Credit Claim Form" by contacting the County Treasurer's Office.

**Am I eligible for the First Dollar Credit?**

If your real estate bill has an "assessed value improvement" amount, the credit should automatically show on your bill. Anyone entitled to the credit that does not receive it must appeal directly to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue.

**NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS:**

Dog owners in the Village of Monticello should purchase their 2018 dog license from the Village Clerk located at 140 N Main St., Monticello. The fee is \$6.00 for altered dogs and \$11.00 for dogs not altered. All current licenses expire December 31, 2018. To obtain a license you must provide the following:

- Proof of rabies vaccination
- Veterinarian proof of alteration
- License Fee
